History of the ANRS | MIE Vietnam site



- **1988:** Beginning of the collaborations between French and Vietnamese researchers with the first course on HIV in Vietnam given by Pr. Françoise Barré-Sinoussi
- **1996:** First official collaboration agreement between MoH Vietnam and ANRS to develop collaboration in the field of scientific research and training on HIV/AIDS
- **2000:** New agreement between Vietnam MoH and ANRS to reinforce the collaboration by **creating the Vietnam ANRS research site, hosted by Pasteur Institute in HCMC.**
- **2014:** Collaboration agreement with Hanoi Medical University
- **2018:** Renewal of the agreement of the year 2000 and **the ANRS coordination office based at VAAC**
- **2018:** Collaboration agreement with Hai Phong University of

- **Role of ANRS sites:**

- To develop and to promote joint actions between MoH and ANRS
- To organize discussions between Vietnamese and French researchers
- To develop research projects relevant to the characteristics of epidemics in Vietnam and jointly selected by the parties
- To support training and capacity building of scientific and technical executives
- To facilitate transfer of technologies
- To provide technical and scientific support to research projects investigators
