SHP Clinic History



Research clinic for HIM HANOI Study (longitudinal observation cohort of 1893 MSM) funded by PEPFAR and CDC US (2016-2020)

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One-Stop-Shop Clinic For Key Populations

- PrEP, PEP, HIV testing, STIs
- SUD, CHEMSEX, and mental health
- 9/2020: Provide PrEP for 1,190 clients

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Research clinic for NIDAfunded study on sexual health promotion for YMSM (RO1DA033673; PIs: Goldsamt, Clatts, Le)

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LAUNCHING SHP CLINIC OF HMUH FOR PrEP

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INTEGRATED INTO DEPARTMENT OF TROPICAL MEDICINE, HMUH


- An important step for referring MSM clients to ARV treatment at HMUH
- Provided PrEP for over 2,300 clients

PrEP: Pre-exposure Prophylaxis STIs: Sexually Transmitted Infections YMMW: Young men who have sex with men HMUH: Hanoi Medical University Hospital SUD: substance use disorder TDHR: Tropical diseases and harm reduction


HIM-Hanoi Study Showed Substantial Risk and Indication for PrEP among MSM

Age group	Time of follow - up (person -years)	Number of HIV seroconv ersion cases	HIV incidence rate (per 100 person-year)
16-24	599.2	45	7.5
25-29	164.6	10	6.1
>=30	114.6	6	5.2



Cumulative PrEP Clients Over Time (95% clients were MSM)








HIV Cases among PrEP Clients at SHP




HIV incident rate recorded in HIM-Hanoi study between 2017 – 2019 (Pre-PrEP period)

HIV incident rate in the oral PrEP program between 2019 – 2022

Study participants	1,498 HIV- MSM	Clients initiated PrEP	3,829 HIV- MSM
Total time follow-up	878 person- year	Total time follow-up	2,811 person- year
HIV seroconversion	61 cases	HIV seroconversion	29 cases
HIV incident rate	6.9 per person- year	HIV incident rate	1.0 per person- year




Screening for HIV, Hepatis, Syphilis (10/2022 – 9/2023)

NAM study (R21AI57817): Evaluating STI screening and antimicrobial resistance in Neisseria gonorrhoeae among PrEP users in Vietnam



-All CT/NG infected clients were offered free treatment.


Screening for Substance Use and CMD (10/2022 – 9/2023)

Proposed Potential Topics for Research

Current Studies (funded by NIH)

- 1. Neisseria Gonorrhea and Antimicrobial Resistance
- 2. Alcohol use and PrEP adherence

Future Studies

- 1. Implementation Science of Strategies to Support On-Demand PrEP Roll-out
- 2. Digital technology to support PrEP adherence (both daily and event-driven)
- 3. Interventions to improve mental health, reduce substance use, reduce STI and reduce HIV incidence
